## From the Tower:

My grand father was a do it yourselfer back when everyone was and there was no terminology for the concept. He had few if any power tools, a hand saw and manual drill is what I mostly remember. He tried to teach me to use these tools. There is one thing in particular he said to me and showed to me that stuck.

He said “let the tool do the work” when I didn’t, and demonstrated the results when you did. The tool in question was easier to use (operate), and worked (performed) better if you didn’t fight or force the tool to do it’s job. You simply guide the tool.

So next time you fly an airplane just guide it. Let the wing and the engine do the work. Put the wing where it needs to be to get the result you desire. Do not “turn” the airplane just bank it to get the turn you want. The ailerons do not turn the airplane they rotate the airplane around an axis. The rudder and elevator work the same way.

One of the jobs of the rudder is to counter the adverse effect of the ailerons. Believe me, if the ailerons move the rudder must move to correct. It simply does not matter if you are raising a wing because of turbulence or banking to induce a turn. If you want to guide the airplane - Coordinate!
