Post Flight Debriefing:

Larry Fink treated us to an interesting and informative talk about a Texan born to Irish-American parents named Douglas Corrigan. In October, 1925, at eighteen, he took a plane ride and was hooked on the love of flying. In 1930, he bought a Curtiss Robin for \$325 from a junk heap and refurbished it for less than nine hundred dollars.

On July 17, 1938, Corrigan took off from Floyd Bennett Field, Long Island for Los Angeles with 320 (cost \$62.26) gallons of fuel. After 28 hours and 13 minutes, he reached land and recognized it as Ireland.

Do you think it was by chance or by design?

This was "Wrong Way" Corrigan.
